## **Link Satellite Site Priorities**

- 23 priorities which sit alongside the subjects taught through the 3 pathways.
- These priorities address key areas of development for our students which aim to address lifelong skills that our students will need to access their education and life.
- Subcategories include:
  - Friendships (2)
  - Spiritual development (1)
  - Readiness/learning to learn (2)
  - Communication (2)
  - ➤ Waiting (1)
  - Community (2)
  - > Emotional development (5)
  - Personal safety (2)
  - Self-help/Healthy lifestyles (5)
  - Sensory processing (1)
- Termly assessment shows the development of students against these areas and priorities. This is a wholistic review of skills within these priorities and not a judgement of the whole priority. Students will be assessed as to whether the development has seen:
  - ➤ Skills lost
  - > Skills the same
  - New skills learnt
  - New skills learnt and generalized

## **IEPS**

- All students will have termly IEP (Individual Education Plan) outcomes which have been written to address small steps towards their EHCP (Education Health Care Plan) outcomes.
- These IEPS will be assessed termly as Achieved/Partly achieved/Not achieved
- SLT will draw from data to define below expected/expected/above expected progress across varying cohorts yearly to give comparative data site.

## Link Satellite Steps (SOLAR)

 Progress will be seen in %. Students will be assessed termly upon small step progress in English and Maths.

- Students' progress in Science, Computing, Citizenship/PSHE, Creative arts, PE and Humanities will be documented as seen by teachers throughout the terms.
- The Link Satellite Steps outcomes for subjects are drawn from Development matters and National Curriculum outcomes and the levels are named as equivalent to i.e. Equivalent birth-3 years, Equivalent Year 2, Equivalent KS1.
- English is split into 7 sub sections:
  - > Reading- comprehension
  - Word reading
  - > Spoken Language
  - > Writing- comprehension
  - Writing- handwriting
  - Writing- spelling
  - Writing- Vocabulary, grammar, punctuation
- Maths is split into 3 sub sections:
  - Number
  - Geometry
  - Using & Applying
- Science is split into 4 subsections:
  - Biology
  - Chemistry
  - Physics
  - Scientific Enquiry
